BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwest side of Rice Street (formerly Henrietta Avenue) at the joint front corner of Lots 73 and 74 and running thence with the Northwest side of Rice Street (formerly Henrietta Avenue), N. 38-18 E. 35 feet to an iron pin; thence along a curved line running to and with Long Hill Street to an iron pin (the chord of which is N. 6-42 W. 35.3 feet to an iron pin); thence with the South side of Long Hill Street on a curved line to an iron pin (the chord of which is No 51-42 We 48.4 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the South side of Long Hill Street on a curved line to an iron pin (the chord of which is N. 69-36 W. 65 feet to an iron pin); thence continuing with the South side of Long Hill Street, N. 87-04 W. 87.9 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 2-56 W. 50 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 73 and 74; thence along the line of Lot 73, S. 67-43 E. 185.2 feet to an iron pin on the Northwest side of Rice Street (formerly Henrietta Avenue) the beginning corner.
