NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Bates Township, adjoining lands of Johnie Bridwell on the north and other lands of M. D. Rice and Florida Rice, on the east side of a branch waters of Enoree River, and having the following metes and bounds:

"BEGINNING at a white oak on west side of said branch as the line in the general direction of N. 21-1/2 E. 3.07 chains to a bend; thence with branch as the line in general direction of N. 64-3/4 W. 4.00 chains to a point in center of branch on L. E. Gaillard line; thence S. 41-3/4 E. 2.80 chains to iron pin on bank of a gully; thence along said gully, S. 13 E. .46 of a chain to iron pin on bank of a gully; thence S. 73-1/2 W. 6.97 chains to the beginning corner, and containing one and one-half (1-1/2) acres, more or less, according to survey made by J. Earle Freeman, 1940; being the same conveyed to me by Taylors Lumber Company, Inc. by deed of even date herewith, not yet recorded."
