in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The First National Bank of Greenville, S. C. as Trustee under agreement with Bessie Norris Tilman dated 7/9/53, its successors and assigns:

All that lot of land situate on the East side of Sir Abbot Street, near the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, being a portion of Lot 114, as shown on the Deed of Conveyance, made by Dalton A. Cover, Administrator, Executor, 1951, to the said Bessie Norris Tilman, recorded in the R.M.O. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Book "B", pages 70 and 71, and having, according to said deed, the following corners and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Southeast side of Sir Abbot Street at Point Street corner of Lots 112 and 113, and running thence with the line of Lot 112, S. 27-14 E., 155 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 62-43 W., 75 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 114, N. 27-14 W., 155 feet to an iron pin on the Southeast side of Sir Abbot Street; thence with the Southeast side of Sir Abbot Street, N. 62-43 E., 75 feet to the beginning corner.
