WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto  
GENERAL MORTGAGE CO.,

a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Ten Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$ 10,400.00), with interest from date at the rate of Four & one-half per centum (4½ %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of General Mortgage Co., in Greenville, South Carolina, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of Fifty-seven and 82/100-----Dollars (\$ 57.82 ), commencing on the first day of July, 1955, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of June, 1980.

Now, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of GREENVILLE, State of South Carolina:

ALL that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate on the South side of Nottingham Road, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S. C., being shown as Lot No. 200 on plat of Sherwood Forest, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, August, 1951, revised through June, 1953, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "GG", pages 2 and 3 (also recorded in Plat Book "GG", pages 70 and 71); said lot fronting 75 feet along the South side of Nottingham Road, running back to a depth of 160 feet on the West side, to a depth of 160 feet on the East side, and being 75 feet across the rear.

This is the same property conveyed to the Mortgagor herein by deed of L. A. Moseley, to be recorded herewith.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.
