Loan Association, Greer, S. C., its successors and assigns:

That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, near the Town of Greer, S. C., fronting on Palmer Street, known and designated as lots nos. 37 and 38 on a plat prepared by W. N. Willis, Surveyor, dated January 19, 1916, and having the following metes and bounds:-

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Palmer Street, corner of lot no. 38 and runs thence with said Street S. 69.29 E. 110 feet to corner of lot no. 36; thence with the line of this lot North 20-31 E. 140 feet to an iron pin; thence N 67.06 W. 89.3 feet to line on lot no. 3; thence S. 28.48 W. 144.7 feet to the beginning.
