TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, **Buford Bridges** (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto **Bank of Travelers Rest, Travelers Rest, S. C.** (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of **Thirteen Hundred Four and 52/100**

DOLLARS (\$1304.52 ),

with interest thereon from date at the rate of **Six** per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid: **\$50.00 on August 7, 1955, and a like payment of \$50.00 on the 7th day of each month thereafter until paid in full, with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six per cent, per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually in advance**

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Saluda Township, West of the Tagaloo Road, about 1½ miles North from Marietta and according to a survey made by J. C. Hill January 8, 1953, is described as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin in a private road, 300 feet more or less Northwest from Tagaloo Road, at corner of property of Clyde Bridges, thence with the line of said property, S. 25 W. 104.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 6 E. 95.9 feet to an iron pin at corner of property of E. C. Robinson; thence with the line of said property, N. 55-30 W. 160.1 feet to an iron pin in line of Cox Estate; thence with the line of Cox Estate, N. 0-30 W. 264.3 feet to an iron pin at corner of other property of Buford Bridges; thence with the line of said property, S. 44-45 E. 231 feet to the beginning corner."

Being the same property conveyed to the mortgagor by E. C. Robinson by deed recorded in Book of Deeds 472 at Page 119. According to the above referred to survey this tract contains 0.76 Acres.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
