Earle dated April 23, 1937,

on the southwestern side of Nelson Street, at No. 5, being portions of lots Nos. 55 and 56 of Washington Heights subdivision according in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "F" page of 109 feet on its eastern side and 97 feet on its western side, and bounds as follows:
