"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Florida Avenue, joint front corner of Lots 173 and 174, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 22-06 W. 111.6 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 172 and 171; thence along the rear line of Lot 171, N. 57-24 E. 81.4 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 175; thence along the line of that lot, S. 22-06 E. 126.7 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of Florida Avenue; thence along the northern side of Florida Avenue, S. 67-54 W. 80 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner; being a portion of the property conveyed to mortgagor corporation by George F. Townes, individually and as trustee by deed recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 517, at page 25."

The above described lot is a portion of Section 2 of the above-mentioned subdivision.
