NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

in Bates Township, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stone on Benson line; thence N. 1-30 W. 8.45 chains to a stone on South bank of creek; thence up the said creek as a line about 15 chains to center line of road that leads to James H. Ballew's home; thence Southwesterly along road as the line 7.06 chains to O. D. Roberts corner; thence with his line, N. 80 W. 8.22 chains to the beginning. Bounded on North and East by James H. Ballew and Annie Mae Ballew, on West by Earl Benson, on South by O. D. Roberts and contains 7½ acres, more or less.
