(\$6.100.00 -) Delians, or for future advances which may be made hereunder, from time to time, up to and including the maximum amount named herein, such advances to be repaid so as to be completed within the terms of the original contract, and so long as the mostly payment set out in the note are paid according to contract, this loan shall not be deemed delinquent by passon of and advances, with inherent at the rate specified in said note,

(the terms of which are incorporated barein by relievance) to be rejuid in installments of in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, known and designated as Lot No. 129, Section 2, of Belmont Heights, according to plat by C. C. Jones dated December 1954, plat of which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book GG, at Page 99, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 129 and 130, and running thence along the line of these lots, N. 65-19 W. 125 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 24-25 E. 126.6 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Kay Drive; thence along Kay Drive, S. 65-35 E. 100 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of Kay Drive and Melvin Drive, which intersection is curved, the chord of which is S. 20-27 E. 34.9 feet to an iron pin on the northwestern side of Melvin Drive; thence with Melvin Drive, S. 24-41 W. 100.6 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning; being the same conveyed to us by Leslie & Shaw, Inc. by deed dated February 13, 1956, not yet recorded."

The above description is at slight variance with the recorded plat hereinabove referred to, but is in accordance with a plat entitled "Revision of Lots 125-145 of Section 2 of Belmont Heights" prepared by C. C. Jones and Associates and bearing date November 6, 1954, which revised plat is to be recorded.
