WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Dunklin Township, containing $32\frac{1}{2}$ acres more or less on the Dunklin Bridge Road, joining lands now or formerly of Mrs. S. A. Ramsey Estate, Mary D. Latimer, W. D. Ridgeway and others and about 23 or 24 miles from the City of Greenville near Labanon Church. BEGINNING on a post oak in the cemetery of said Lebanon Church; thence S. 57 3/4 E. 20. 18 chains to post oak stump thence N. $39\frac{1}{2}$ E. 3. 37 chains to stake; thence N. 41/4 W. $32\frac{1}{2}$ chains to stake; thence S. 73 3/8 W. 1.63 chains to Red Oak stump; thence S. 31 3/4 W. $26\frac{1}{2}$ chains to the beginning corner in cemetery, less 14.44 acres which property was conveyed by W. D. Ridgeway to W. M. Caldwell on February 19, 1918 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 42 at Page 338.
