TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: I, Mrs. Mary E. Smith, formerly
Mary E. Cornwell,

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto GREER FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREER, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of

EIGHT THOUSAND

DOLLARS (\$ 8,000.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six

per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, ~~in the City of~~ Greer and in Chick Springs Township, known and designated as Lot No. 18 on a plat of property made for Evelyn Gentry by H.S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated November 8, 1950, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book P, at page 3, and having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of Vandevanter Street, joint corner of Lots Nos. 18 and 19 on said plat, and thence with the common line of said lots N. 0.42 E. 251 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 78.54 W. 50 feet to an iron pin, rear corner of Lots Nos. 17 and 18; thence with the line of said lots S. 7.31 W. 262 feet to an iron pin on Vandevanter Street; thence therewith S. 89.12 E. 80 feet to the beginning corner.

The above property is one of the lots conveyed to the late James K. Cornwall by Evelyn Gentry by deed dated July 31, 1946, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 297, at page 234.

The above property was inherited by the mortgagor and Faith C. Karas. See deed on record in Greenville County R.M.C. Office conveying interest of Faith Karas to mortgagor.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
