County, State of South Carolina, about 7 miles South of the City of Greenville
on the west side of Augusta Road, more fully described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the West side of the Augusta Road
on line of land now or formerly owned by W. M. Stenhouse and running thence
along said line N. 86-30 W. 253.5 feet to a stone by an iron pin; thence S. 17
W. 211 feet to a stake; thence N. 88-05 E. 317.4 feet to a stake at the Augusta
Road; thence along said Road N. 1-30 W. 180.3 feet to the beginning corner and
