TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: I, Charles H. Knight

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto LAURENS FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, LAURENS, S. C. (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee), as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Six Thousand Six Hundred Fifty and No/100-----

DOLLARS (\$ 6650.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of six----- (6 %) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville in Dunklin Township, containing one acre more or less, having the following boundaries: Beginning at an iron pin, which is the common corner with Essie Mae Weeks, and running S. 72 degrees 258 1/2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 35 degrees W 360 feet to center of Pelzer-Williamston road; thence N. 30 1/2 degrees W. 203 feet; thence 15 1/4 degrees E. 203 feet to beginning corner, and bounded on the North by lands of G. S. Knight; on the East by lands of Essie Mae Weeks; on the South by lands of Cothran and on the West by a State Highway known as the Beach Spring Road.

This being the identical land conveyed to the mortgagor by J. G. Cothran, et al, by deed dated December 7, 1953, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 490, page 297.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
