We, James E. Patterson and Gladys B. Patterson of Greenville, South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagor, send(s) greetings:

All that lot of land in the city of Greenville, county of Greenville, state of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 1, on plat of property of Mack E. Henry recorded in Plat Book JJ at Page 100 of the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., and having accord- to a recent survey made June 1956 by R. W. Dalton, the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the westerly side of Keith Drive the front joint corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2, which iron pin is 182.2 feet in a northerly direction from the northwest corner of Keith Drive and Eisenhower Drive; and running thence with the joint line of said lots south 77-28 W 150 feet to an iron pin; thence N 15-58 W 83 feet to an iron pin; thence N 80-53 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on the westerly side of Keith Drive; thence with the westerly side of said Keith Drive S 16-15 E 75 feet to the beginning corner.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.
