All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Butler Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 2, as shown on plat of property of Morningside, as made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in December 1952, which plat is of record in the R.M.C. Office for said County and State in Plat Book "EE", at pages 2 and 3, reference to which plat is hereby made, said lot of land being described by metes and bounds, as follows, to-wit:
