

Tract 4: All that certain tract of land, containing one hundred forty-six (146) acres, more or less, in Ware Shoals (#51) School District, of Laurens County, State of South Carolina, approximately three-fourths of a mile east of Ware Shoals, north of Saluda River, on State Highway #S-30-47; bounded, now or formerly as follows: North and northeast by lands of Mrs. J. T. Johnson; east by lands of Roy Thompson and M. O. Jones; south by State Highway #S-30-47; and west by lands of Riegat Textile Corporation and Mrs. J. T. Johnson. Said tract of land is more particularly described according to plat prepared by W. J. Hodges, Surveyor, on the 6th day of April, 1951, designated as drawing #51-19 of Riegat Textile Corporation, and recorded in the Office of the Clerk of Court for Laurens County in Plat Book 10, page 270, which plat and the record thereof are by reference incorporated herein.

Tract 5: All that certain tract of land, containing eighty-three and nine-tenths (83.9) acres, more or less, in Dials #5 School District, of Laurens County, State of South Carolina, approximately 2-1/2 miles northeast from the Town of Swings, on State Highway between Swings and Durben; bounded now or formerly as follows: North by lands of J. C. Swings; east by lands of R. L. Cook and Sam Stoddard, Durbin Creek the line in part; on southwest by lands of R. L. Rogers and George Swings; on northwest by lands of W. B. Stewart. Said tract of land being more particularly described according to plat prepared by C. A. Broadway, Jr., and A. W. Schoolbred, Jr., Surveyors, on the \_\_\_ day of December, 1954, which said plat is recorded in Plat Book 10, page 67, Office of the Clerk of Court for Laurens County, and to which reference is hereto made for a more particular description of the courses and distances of said tract.

Tract 6: All that certain tract of land, containing one hundred seventy-six and five-tenths (176.5) acres, more or less, in School District 390, Glassy Mountain Township of Greenville County, State of South Carolina, approximately three miles from Gwansville, on both sides of S. C. Highway #11, and being particularly described according to plat prepared by J. Q. Bruce, Surveyor, on the \_\_\_ day of October, 1955, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book LL, page 23 as follows: Beginning at a nail in the center of S. C. Highway No. 11, corner of Ollie Plumley property, and running thence south 87 degrees west 56.2 feet to an iron pin; thence north 5 degrees west 917 feet to an iron pin; thence north 9 degrees 45 minutes west 676.5 feet to an iron pin; thence north 63 degrees 40 minutes east 918.5 feet to an iron pin, corner of Morgan property; thence south 84 degrees 45 minutes east 1034 feet to an old stone; thence south 7 degrees 45 minutes west 1050 feet to an iron pin; thence north 80 degrees 20 minutes east 362.5 feet to point in old Squirrel Mountain Road; thence north 39 degrees 45 minutes east 334 feet to an iron pin in said road; thence north 59 degrees 45 minutes east 295 feet to an iron pin on edge of said road; thence south 74 degrees 30 minutes east 300 feet to old stone on ridge; thence south 84 degrees 45 minutes east 1071 feet to an iron pin on west bank of new road; thence in a southerly direction with center of old road 957.7 feet, more or less, to iron pin, corner of property now or formerly owned by J. M. Green; thence south 72 degrees 10 minutes west 1223.5 feet, crossing S. C. Highway No. 11, to a cross on large flat rock

(north edge of old road); thence south 81 degrees west 260 feet; thence north 69 degrees west 200 feet; thence north 61 degrees 40 minutes west 500 feet; thence north 60 degrees west 400 feet; thence north 72 degrees west 200 feet; thence north 88 degrees west 200 feet to a point in old road; thence with said old road, in a westerly direction 779 feet, more or less, to point in said road; thence south 73 degrees 50 minutes west 492 feet to a point; thence south 7 degrees east 693 feet to an oak (old 3x); thence with line of Ollie Plumley north 50 degrees west 1254 feet to the beginning corner.

ALSO: All that certain tract of land just west of and adjoining the above described tract, containing seven and six-tenths (7.6) acres (or also described as containing 12 acres), in Greenville County, South Carolina, and being particularly described according to plat prepared by J. Q. Bruce, Surveyor, on the \_\_\_ day of October, 1955, above referred to as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on property line of Morgan and running thence north 35 degrees 20 minutes west 832 feet to an iron pin just south of Green's Creek; thence south 16 degrees 35 minutes west 1024.5 feet to an old stone; thence north 68 degrees 20 minutes east 830 feet to the beginning corner.

Tract 7: All that certain tract of land, containing one hundred and thirteen (113) acres, more or less, in Westminster (#17) School District, of Oconee County, State of South Carolina; and bounded now or formerly by lands of Mrs. Ida Jenkins and of C. M. Galloway and others and by Chauga Creek, on the north and west. Said tract of land being more particularly described according to plat prepared by Harry U. Earle, Surveyor, on the 1st day of February, 1955, which said plat is recorded in Plat Book 9 at page 36, Office of the Clerk of Court for Oconee County, and to which reference is hereto made for a more particular description of the courses and distances of said tract.
