To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, Lottie A. Howell

SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said Lottie A. Howell
in and by a certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these
Presents, am well and truly indebted to H. L. Davenport
in the full and just sum of seven hundred and sixty dollars (\$760.00)
to be paid at the rate of thirty dollars (\$30.00) per
week hereafter until paid in full,

, with interest thereon from maturity
at the rate of six per centum per annum, to be computed and paid monthly
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear
interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid,
the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the
hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof
necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage
in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises
to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to
the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

gained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
H. L. Davenport, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the improvements
thereon, in Greenville County, S. C., on the eastern side of Elrod
Street (formerly Williams Street) near the City of Greenville,
being known and designated as Lot No. 11 as shown on plat of
Goodwin property, recorded in Book NNN at page 484, and being more
particularly described as follows:
BEGINNING at a stake on the eastern side of Elrod Street (formerly
Williams Street) at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 11 and 12, and
running thence with Elrod Street, S. 21-20 E. 70 feet to stake,
corner of Lot No. 10; thence with the line of Lot 10, N. 59 1/4 E.
193 feet to stake on Wright Street; thence with Wright Street,
N. 21-20 W. 70 feet to a stake, corner of Lot 12; thence with the
line of said Lot S. 59-1/4 W. 193 feet to the beginning corner.
