Now, Know All Men, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

ALL that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate on the East side of Heard Drive, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S. C., being shown as Lot No. 44 on plat of Belmont Heights, made by C. C. Jones, Engineer, April, 1954, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "GG", at Pages 54 and 55, and having, according to said plat, and a recent survey made by R. W. Dalton, Surveyor, October, 1956, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Heard Drive at joint front corner of Lots 43 and 44, and running thence along the line of Lot 43, N 73-15 E, 205 feet to a point in center of branch; thence with the center of branch in a general Southerly direction (the traverse lines being S 32-30 W, 36 feet; S 47-46 E, 63 feet, and S 27-04 E, 65.4 feet) to a point in center of branch; thence with the line of Lot 45, S 85-52 W, 242 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Heard Drive; thence along the curve of Heard Drive (the chord being N 10-10 W, 90 feet) to the beginning corner.
