RELEASE

For value received the Fidelity Federal Savings and Loan Association of Greenville, South Carolina, owner and holder of the mortgage executed by C. E. Jones and Associates the 13th day of December, 1956 the following metes and bounds to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeasterly side of Hammett Street which iron pin is the joint corner of other property owned by the mortgagor and running thence along the Southeasterly side of Hammett Street N. 46-46 E. 81.4 ft. to an iron pin on a 10 foot alley; thence along said 10 foot alley S. 1-02 E. 120.4 ft. to an iron pin; thence N. 42-37 W. 89 ft. to an iron pin the point of beginning."

The execution and delivery hereof shall not, in any manner, effect the liens of mortgage nor its terms in any respect except in so far as the release of the above described land from said mortgage.
