"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being on the Western side of Long Hill Street, in the City of Greenville, being shown as part of lot #87, and a part of lot #85 on a revised plat of Augusta Road Ranches, recorded in Plat Book Mat Page 47, that portion of lot 87 also being shown as Parcel A on plat made by Pickell & Pickell recorded in Plat Book R at Page 55, and when described together have the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
