Welborn—The signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granter, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. E. Welborn and Joyce B. Welborn:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about three miles from the City of Greenville, on the South side of Anderson Road, on State Highway No. 81 and being shown and designated as the Western portion of Tract No. 14, as shown on plat of property of First Carolinas Joint Stock Land Bank of Columbia, S. C., and described in plat of property of Dixie Farm formerly property of First Carolinas Joint Stock Land Bank, which plat was revised by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, February, 1939, yet unrecorded, and being more particularly described on said above referred to plat as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the Anderson Road, which point is two hundred (200) feet West of the joint corners of Tracts Nos. 14 and 14-A and running thence along the South side of said Anderson Road S. 71-20 W. 226 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Anderson Road, joint line of property now or formerly belonging to L.
