WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Ten Thousand Eight Hundred and No/100 - - - - - - - - - - - - -

DOLLARS (\$ 10,800.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of five and one-half $(5\frac{1}{2}\%)$ per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the City of Greenville, on the western side of McPherson Lane, being known and designated as the greater portion of Lot 27 on plat of property of the Estate of T. Q. Donaldson recorded in Plat Book H at Page 284, in the R. M. C. Office, and having according to a more recent survey by H. C. Crouch, Engineer, dated November 14, 1951, to have the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of McPherson Lane, said pin being 161.1 feet north of the intersection of Camille Avenue and McPherson Lane and running thence along the rear line of Lots 14 and 15 N. 84-54 W. 171.6 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 11-29 E. 90.7 feet to a point on the dividing line of Lots 27 and 28; thence with the line of Lot 28 S. 78-20 E. 170.5 feet to an iron pin on the western side of McPherson Lane; thence along the western side of McPherson Lane S. 11-29 W. 71 feet to the beginning corner."

Being the same property conveyed to the mortgagor by deed of Eleanor E. McGregor to be recorded herewith.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
