C. Railroad right-of-way extending from Ebaugh Avenue to the Laurens Road, as shown on plat of East Park, recorded in Plat Book "A" at Page 383, in the R.M.C. Office, and as more particularly shown on a Plat of property of East Park Baptist Church prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service June 9, 1949, and when described as a whole has the following metes and bounds, according to later mentioned plat:
