To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, I. O. GOODWIN, JR. SEND GREETING:  
Whereas, I, the said I. O. Goodwin, Jr. hereinafter called the mortgagor(s)

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to R. W. MANLEY

hereinafter called the mortgagee(s), in the full and just sum of Sixteen Hundred Fifty-five and 73/100 ----- DOLLARS (\$1655.73), to be paid

, with interest thereon from date at the rate of six (6%) percentum per annum, to be computed and paid

monthly until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if, before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor(s) promise to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

Office for Greenville County in Plat Book EE at page 6, and having according to a recent survey by T. C. Adams, Engineer, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeast side of Woodbriar Court at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 21 and 22, point of beginning being 281 feet to Indigo Street, and running thence with the south-east side of said Woodbriar Court, N. 39-25 E. 74 feet to an iron pin, the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 20 and 21; thence with the line of Lot No. 20, S. 50-35 E. 152.4 feet to an iron pin, the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 20 and 21; thence S. 35-14 W. 74.3 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 21 and 22; thence with the line of Lot No. 22, N. 50-35 W. 157.7 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.
