

Fifty & no/100 (\$ 50.00) dollars due and payable on the 5th day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the full principal sum, with interest and all costs, insurance, and expenses incurred in connection with said loan, has been paid, said monthly payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, and then to payment of principal, costs, expenses and insurance, if any

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I the said Mittle Allen Fleming, in consideration of the said debt and sums of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said CTTIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to me the said mortgagor... in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said CTTIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., its successors and assigns:
