C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Ninety-five Hundred and No/100 -----), with interest thereon from date at the rate of five & three-fourths/ DOLLARS (\$ 9500.00 per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successsors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, lying on the western corner of the intersection of Patricia Avenue and Range View Drive in Gantt Township, near the City of Greenville, being shown and designated as Lot 16 on plat of White Horse Heights prepared by C. C. Jones dated December 20, 1952, recorded in Plat Book BB at Page 135, according to said plat being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwestern side of Range View Drive front corner of Lot 17 and running thence with the southwestern side of Range View Drive S. 41-08 E. 126.6 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of Range View Drive and Patricia Avenue; thence with the northwestern side of Patricia Avenue S. 48-52 W. 170.4 feet to an iron pin front corner of Lot 28; thence with the line of said lot N. 41-08 W. 126.6 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot 17; thence with the line of said lot N. 48-52 E. 170.4 feet to the beginning corner.
