

Presents, am well and truly indebted to Citizens Bank

The sum of Fifty-Seven and 62/100 (\$57.62) Dollars commencing on the 9th day of December, 1957, and a like amount on the 9th day of each succeeding month until paid in full with payments to be applied first to interest and then to principal.

, with interest thereon from date

at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid monthly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear,

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land with the building and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the Northwest side of Georgia Road, limited East of the Town of Simpsonville, in Austin Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, containing 7.65 Acres, more or less, according to a plat prepared by E. E. Gary, Surveyor, dated October 29, 1947, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of Georgia Road, iron pin being on the Northwest side of said road at the joint front corner of property now or formerly of W. W. Mayfield and of Charles A.
