interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid,  
the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the  
hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof  
necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage

or less, lying, being and situate in the County and State aforesaid,  
Oaklawn Township, and being bounded by Fork Shoals-Greenville Road,  
John Sullivan, Mrs. W. H. Riddle, Mrs. Ross, et al. This being the  
same tract of land conveyed to the mortgagor by deed of Lydia Boyce  
Crumpton et al on October 7, 1946, of record in the Office of the R. M.  
C. for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed 300, Page 158, to which re-  
ference is made for a better description as to lines, corners, distances,  
etc.
