WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto

called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which
are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of EIGHT THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED & NO/100-
Dollars (\$ 8,200.00), with interest from date at the rate of five and one-fourth per centum
(5 1/4 %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of
C. Douglas Wilson & Co. in Greenville, South Carolina
or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of
Fifty-Five and 27/100- ----- Dollars (\$ 55.27),
commencing on the first day of February, 1958, and on the first day of each month there-
after until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest,
if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of January, 1978.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better
securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three
Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing
and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained,
sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its
successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville,
State of South Carolina:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon,
situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of
South Carolina, being known and designated as a Part of Lot No. 72, Augusta Road
Hills, plat of which is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South
Carolina, in Plat Book "M", page 33, and having, according to said plat, the
following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwesterly side of Rice Street (formerly Henrietta
Avenue) in the Northwest intersection of Rice Street and Long Hill Street, and run-
ning thence along Rice Street S. 38-18 W. 35 feet to an iron pin; thence around the
curve of the intersection of Rice Street and Long Hill Street, the chord of which is
S. 83-18 W. 35.3 feet to an iron pin on Long Hill Street; thence along Long Hill
Street N. 51-42 W. 48.4 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along Long Hill Street
N. 69-24 W. 39.3 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 36-48 E. 71.9 feet to an iron pin in
the line of Lot No. 71; thence along the line of Lot No. 71 S. 51-42 E. 112.3 feet
to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter
attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.
