Wood, Estate as shown on a sjudivision and plat of same made by H S. Brockman, Reg. Surveyor, dated October 28, 1955, said plat being of record in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book GG, page 151 and having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances as shown by said plat, so wit:
