Whereas Hazel C. Edwards, the owner of lots 1, 2 and 3 on plat of property of W.H. Campbell recorded in the R.M.C. Office in the County of Greenville, S.C. in plat book NN at page 63;

Whereas Hazel C. Edwards did execute unto E.E. Hawkins as will appear by reference to mortgage book 735 at page 459, and the property encumbered by said mortgage was lot # 1, in the sum of \$_____. Said mortgage contained a clause that the mortgagee was to have the right under the mortgage, the same being a part of the security, to run a water line over and across lot 2 from the well located on lot 3.

Now therefore, in order that the title to lot 2 shall not be encumbered and controlled by said mortgage to E.E. Hawkins, so that the same is unusable during the life of said mortgage;

It is hereby agreed by and between E.E. Hawkins and Hazel C. Edwards that the right of way to lay a pipe line from lot 3 over and across lot 2, to reach lot 1 is hereby amended and changed in that said right of way to lay said pipe line shall be confined and limited to the rear five (5) feet of lot #2. It is agreed that E. E. Hawkins shall have the right to run said pipe line, but only over the rear five feet of lot #2.
