"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, lying on the Northwestern side of New Highway 291 in Gantt Township, containing 2 acres, more or less, and according to a survey of the property of the mortgagors prepared by J. C. Hill, dated September 3, 1957, having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on New Highway 291 and running thence with said Highway, the chord of which is N. 55-25 E. 181.9 feet to an iron pin, corner of property now or formerly of N. S. Carrison; thence with the line of said property N. 51-15 W. 465.5 feet to an iron pin in line of said property; thence continuing with the line of said property S. 51-30 W. 206.3 feet to an iron pin on a county road; thence with said road S. 47-50 E. 400.1 feet to an iron pin on the said road; thence S. 86-30 E. 78.6 feet to the beginning corner.
