ALL those four lots of land in Greenville County, South Carolina known and designated as Lots #70, #71, #72 and #73 of a subdivision known as Glendale Heights, as shown by a plat thereof made by J. Mac Richardson, February, 1958 and recorded in the Greenville County R. M. C. Office in Plat Book "KK", at page 143, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:
