, to be paid as follows: \$125.00 on October 1, 1958 and
\$125.00 on the first day of each month thereafter until paid in full

, with interest thereon from September 1, 1958
at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid monthly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid,
