ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with all improximents thereon situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, at the Southwest corner of Mills Avenue and Mission Street and being shown as Lot No. 1, Block G on plat of property of O. P. Mills, made by R. E. Dalton, C.E. in April 1924 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F, at page 171 and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:
