NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and telease unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

in Greenville Township, being known and designated as the Northeastern one-half of Lot No. 29 of Section B as shown on Plat of property of H. H. and Alice M. Willis recorded in Plat Book J, at page 161, and being more particularly described according to said Plat as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeast side of Willis Avenue, at the joint front corner of Lots No. 29 and 30 of Section B, and running thence with joint line of said lots, S. 70 E. 310 feet to an iron pin; thence along the rear line of Lot No. 29, S. 36-15 E. 100 feet to a point in the center of the rear line of said lot; thence through the center of Lot No. 29 in a Northwesterly direction to a point in the Southeast side of Willis Avenue, which point is the center of the front line of Lot No. 29; thence with the curve of Willis Avenue, the chord of which is N. 19-32 E. 75 feet to the point of beginning.
