WHEREAS I, James E. Burger

to be paid \$100.00 120 days from date and \$100.00 each succeeding 120 days thereafter until paid in full, with payments to be applied first to the semi-annual interest payments and then to the principal

with interest

from 90 days from date at the rate of six per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid semi-annually, and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said James E. Burger

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Citizens Lumber Company, a corporation, its successors and assigns:

ALL these two lots of land in Greenville County, South Carolina known and designated as Lots #40 and #41 of a subdivision known and designated as Glendale Heights, as shown on a plat thereof, made by J. Mac Richardson, February, 1958 and recorded in the Greenville County R. M. C. Office in Plat Book "KK", at page 143, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Glendale Street at the corner of Lot #42 and running thence with the western side of Glendale Street, N. 6-45 W., 120 feet to a pin at the interesection of Glendale Street and Dresden Avenue; thence with said intersection (the traverse of the curve being N. 51-45 W., 28.3 feet) to a pin on the southern side of Dresden Avenue; thence with the southern side of Dresden Avenue, N. 83-15 W., 110 feet to a pin at the rear corner of Lot #56; thence with the rear lines of Lots #56 and #55, S. 6-45 E., 140 feet to a pin at the corner of Lot #42; thence with the line of Lot #42, N. 83-15 E., 130 feet to the point of beginning.
