Dollars, in and by our certain promissory note in writing of even date herewith, due and payable

Twenty Five and No/100 Dollars (\$25.00) per month commencing December 1, 1958, and  
Twenty Five and No/100 Dollars (\$25.00) on the first day of each and every month  
thereafter until paid in full, with the privilege of anticipating any or all of  
the balance due at any time.

with interest from date at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum  
until paid; interest to be computed and paid annually and if unpaid when due to  
bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and we have further promised and agreed to pay ten per  
cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal proceed-  
ings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we, the said James H. Thompson and Joanne U. Thompson --

----- in consideration of the said debt and sum of money  
aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in  
consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing  
and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and  
released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Guy B. Foster, his  
heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements  
thereon, situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, O'Neal Township,  
located near Sandy Flat, lying on the Northeast side of the Buncombe Road, being  
bounded on the Northwest and Northeast by other lands of Theron Earl Willis, on the  
Southeast by lands of Mrs. Mary Bearden and on the Southwest by the said Buncombe  
Road, and being a part of a 17.46 acre tract conveyed to Theron Earl Willis by deed  
from Will Coleman during the year 1939, and having the following courses and distances,  
to-wit:

BEGINNING on a nail and stopper in the center of the said Buncombe Road, joint corner  
of Mrs. Mary Bearden lands, and runs thence with the said Bearden line N. 52-13 E. 18  
feet to an iron pin on the bank of the road, thence continuing with the same course  
N. 52-13 E. for a total distance of 191 feet to an iron pin in the center of a water-

One-hundredths (0.44) of one acre, more or less.
