Douglas Wilson & Co., in the City of Greenville, S. C., or at such other place either within or without the State of South Carolina, as the owner of this obligation may from time to time designate, of the sum of
Dollars (\$ 8,000.00)
with interest thereon from the date hereof at the rate of $5\frac{1}{2}$ per centum per annum, said interest
to be paid on the lst. day of December 1958 and thereafter said interest
and principal sum to be paid in installments as follows: Beginning on thelstday
of January 1959, and on the 1st. day of each month thereafter the
sum of \$_65.37 to be applied on the interest and principal of said note, said payments to continue
up to and including the 1st. day of November , 1973, and the balance
of said principal sum to be due and payable on the lst. day of
the aforesaid monthly payments of \$_65.37each are to be applied first to interest at the rate
of $5\frac{1}{2}$ per centum per annum on the principal sum of \$3,000.00 or so much thereof as shall from time to time remain unpaid and the balance of each monthly payment shall be applied on account of principal. Said principal and interest to be paid at the par of exchange and net to the obligee, it being thereby expressly agreed that the whole of the said principal sum shall become due after default in the payment of interest, taxes, assessments, water rate or insurance, as hereinafter provided.

Now, Know All Men, that the said Mortgagor in consideration of the said debt and sum of money mentioned in the condition of the said note and for the better securing the payment of the said sum of money mentioned in the condition of the said note with the interest thereon, and also for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid by the said Mortgagee, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, conveyed and released and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, convey and release unto the said Mortgagee and to its successors, legal representatives and assigns, foreven, all that parcel, piece or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown and designated as Lot No. 59, Plat 2, of Sunset Hills, and, according to plat prepared by R. E. Dalton, December, 1945, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book P at page 19, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwestern side of Seminole Drive, at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 58 and 59, and running thence with the line of said lots, S. 48-50 W., 175 feet to an iron pin on a five foot strip reserved for utilities; thence with said strip, N. 41-10 W., 75 feet; thence N. 48-50 E., 175 feet to an iron pin on Seminole Drive; thence with the southwestern side of Seminole Drive, S. 41-10 E., 75 feet to the point of beginning.
