
and State of South Carolina to wit: **TRACT 1.** All that piece, parcel or tract of land


in Greenville County, State of South Carolina on the White Horse Road, near the Columbia and Greenville Railroad, containing 5 acres, more or less, and described as follows: Beginning on a stake 3xo; thence N. 10 E. 6.20 chains to a stone 3xo; thence N. 77 W. 7.50 chains to a stone 3xom; thence S. 10 W. 6.20 chains to a stone 3xm; thence S. 77 E. 8.50 chains to the beginning, being the same premises conveyed to the mortgagor by deed recorded in Deed Book DD, Page 121, less, however, a tract conveyed to H. S. Garrison by deed recorded in Book of Deeds 267, Page 78 containing .56 acre.

TRACT 2. Also all that tract of land on the White Horse Road, County and State heretofore mentioned, described as follows: BEGINNING at a point in the middle of the White Horse Road 28 feet south of an iron pin and 74 feet west of another iron pin; thence S. 74-39 E. 264 feet to a point in H.
