## MORTGAGE

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto

organized and existing under the laws of South Carolina, a corporation hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Nine Thousand Nine Hundred & No/100 Dollars (\$ 9,900.00), with interest from date at the rate of five and one-fourth per centum (5-1/4%) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of C. Douglas Wilson & Co. in Greenville, South Carolina, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of Sixty Six and 73/100----- Dollars (\$ 66.73), commencing on the first day of March, 19 59, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of February, 19 79.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 228, Section "A", Woodfields, plat of which is recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "W", page 75, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeasterly side of North Beaver Lane joint corner with Lot 229, and running thence N. 1-30 E. 145.5 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot 227 S. 60-42 E. 147.1 feet to an iron pin on Foxhall Road; thence along Foxhall Road S. 25-54 W. 85 feet to an iron pin; thence around the curve of the intersection of Foxhall Road and North Beaver Lane, the chord of which is S. 70-54 W. 38 feet to an iron pin on North Beaver Lane; thence along North Beaver Lane N. 73-01 W. 62.7 feet to an iron pin, the point of Beginning.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.
