

at the rate of 6% per centum per annum, to be computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being in Grove Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina containing 2 acres, more orless, and having according to a plat prepared by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, dated November 6, 1951, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of a county road, and running thence along the center of said county road, S. 60-20 W. 186 feet to an iron pin in the center of said road; thence S. 14-30 E. 484 feet to a stake on property of the grantor; thence along the line of other property of the grantor, N. 60-20 E. property of Ben Evans, N. 14-30 W. 484 feet to a stake in the middle of the county road the beginning corner.
