ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lots Nos. 13 and 14 on the Northern side of Cobb Street as shown on plat of New Hope recorded in Plat Book A, at page 307 and being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows:
