MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I. Bertha C. Martin Johnson, of Greenville County.

SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, I/we the aforesaid mortgagor(s) in and by my/our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am/are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION OF

GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of Fifteen Thousand and No/100 - - - - (\$ 15,000,00) Dollars (or for future advances which may be made hereunder at the option of said Association, which advances shall not exceed the maximum amount stated herein and shall be evidenced by a subsequent promissory note or notes se-

cured hereby), said note to be repaid with interest at the rate specified therein in installments of

One Hundred, Five and 32/100 - - - - - (\$ 105.32) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest, has been paid, such monthly payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal. The last payment on said note, if not paid earlier and if not subsequently

extended, will be due and payable 20 years after date. The note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder, become immediately due and payable, and the holder may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Paris Mountain Township, as is more fully shown according to a plat of property of Bertha C. Martin, prepared March 19, 1959 by R. B. Bruce, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book ____, at page ____, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at a point on the northeastern side of Duncan Road, which point is 160 feet southwest from the intersection of said Duncan Road and Hunt's Bridge Road, and running thence along the line of property of Bertha C. Martin, N. 31-53 W. 236.7 feet to a point; and running thence along the line of property of Bertha C. Martin, S. 42-0 W. 300 feet to a point in the line of property now or formerly of J. O. Crawford; and running thence along the line of property now or formerly of J. O. Crawford, S. 31-02 E. 224.9 feet to a point on the northeastern side of said Duncan Road; and running thence along the northeastern side of said Duncan Road; N. 46-03 E. 150 feet to a point on the northeastern side of said Duncan Road; thence continuing still along the northeastern side of said Duncan Road, N. 42-34 E. 150 feet to the point of beginning; being a portion of the property acquired by Bertha Crawford Martin from the estate of her husband, Cecil D. Martin, as is more fully shown in the records of the Probate Court in Apt. 661, File No. 10 and also being a portion of the property conveyed to Bertha C. Martin by E. R. Hawkins by his deed dated August 1, 1957 and recorded in Deed Vol. 599, at page 91."
