(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto CHARLES V. MCKITTRICK

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Twenty-nine Hundred Fifty-one and No/100 -----

DOLLARS (\$ 2951.00),

with interest thereon from date at the rate of five (5%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid:

on or before April 19, 1962 with interest thereon from date at the rate of five (5%) per cent, per annum, to be computed and paid semiannually

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, about 3½ miles west of Simpsonville, Austin Township, containing 38 acres, more or less, and according to plat of property of J. C. Rushton by W. J. Riddle May 18, 1927, is described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of Log Shoals Road on the eastern edge of Stoney Creek and running thence with the center of said road in a southeasterly direction 1290 feet more or less to a point in the center of said road in the line of property now or formerly of M. P. Brown; thence N. 5-45 E. 1398 feet more or less to a post oak; thence N. 61-25 W. 1460 feet to a white oak on the eastern bank of Stoney Creek; thence with and down said creek on the line S. 8-10 E. 688 feet to a point; thence still with said creek S. 13-10 E. 477 feet; thence still with said creek S. 27-15 W. 302 feet to the beginning.

Being the same premises conveyed to the mortgagors by deed of Charles V. McKittrick to be recorded.

It is understood and agreed that this mortgage is junior in lien to a mortgage held by Fidelity Federal Savings & Loan Association in the amount of \$11,000.00.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
