EXTENSION AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made this 3rd day of June, 1960, between the Carolina Federal Savings and Loan Association of Greenville, South Carolina, a corporation chartered under the laws of the United States, hereinafter called "CAROLINA", and Herbert E. Rudd and Jack E. Shaw of Greenville, South Carolina, hereinafter called "OBLIGOR".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Carolina is the owner and holder of a note dated April 1, 1960, executed by Herbert E. Rudd and Jack E. Shaw and delivered to Carolina in the original principal amount of Ten Thousand Five Hundred and no/100ths (\$10,500.00) Dollars, and secured by a mortgage upon the premises, Lot No. 123, as shown on a plat prepared by J. Mac Richardson, R.L.S., dated March, 1960, entitled "Final Plat, Part of Section 2, Orchard Acres", near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being more particularly described in the aforesaid mortgage which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Mortgage Book 820, at page 162.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual agreements hereinafter expressed:

1. Carolina agrees to and hereby does extend the time for payment of \$10,500.00 which now remains unpaid under the obligation so that it shall be payable as follows: \$75.24 on the first day of July, 1960, and a like payment of \$75.24 upon the first day of each
