with interest from date at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid every nine months and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Roland M. Knight

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Executors and Executrices of the last wills and testaments of Eugene Earle Stone, deceased and T. C. Stone, deceased, their successors and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 21 of a subdivision known as Stone Lake Heights, Section III, as shown on a plat of a portion thereof prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, October 1, 1958 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book QQ, at page 97, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western edge of Stono Drive, the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 20 and 21, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 71-37 W. 259.0 feet to an iron pin on the eastern edge of the Chick Springs Road; thence along the eastern edge of the Chick Springs Road, N. 20-15 E. 100.0 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 21 and 22; thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 76-08 E. 248.1 feet to an iron pin on the western edge of Stono Drive; thence along the western edge of Stono Drive, S. 14-25 W. 120.0 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to me by Lewis L. Alexander, Jr. by deed of even date, to be recorded herewith.

And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said mortgagee, their successors ~~Heirs~~ and Assigns, from and against me, my Heirs, Executors, Administrators and Assigns, and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof.
