That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the scaling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby adknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns.

In the City of Greenville, fronting 150 feet on the southern side of Birnie Street and extending 217% feet to the rear and containing 3/4 of an acre, more or less.
