WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELTTY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., Objectinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Fifty-five Hundred and No/100

DOLLARS (\$ 5500.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid in monthly instalments of Fifty-five and No/100 ------ Dollars (\$ 55.00) each on the first day of each month hereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid; each payment to be applied first to payment of interest and then to payment of principal, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose, including advances made by the Mortgagee on other or no security:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to sectire the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagor at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagor, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagor at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagor, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, lying on the northwestern side of Brookway Drive in the City of Greenville, designated as Lots 13 and 14, Block D, on plat of Grove Park, recorded in Plat Book J, Pages 68 and 69, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwestern side of Brookway Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 12 and 13, which pin is located 300 feet from the northeastern intersection of Brookway Drive and Lynn Street and running thence along the northwestern side of Brookway Drive N. 48-02 E. 50 feet to an iron pin joint front corner of Lot 15; thence along the line of Lot 15 N. 44-33 W. 197.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 45-10 W. 49.86 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lot 12; thence along the line of Lot 12 S.44-33 E. 195 feet to the beginning corner.
